UNDERSTANDING COST VS. VALUE

Since 1987, Zonda Media has conducted research on the value of various home remodeling projects. The results are published in their annual Cost vs. Value Report, available at costvsvalue.com.



The data is collected from a survey of more than 6,000 realtors across the United States. Participants were asked what value various remodel projects would have on the typical homes sold in their market. This was then compared with Zonda's estimate of costs for each remodel.



The report includes popular upscale and midrange home improvement projects, and ranks them by cost, resale value, and cost recouped.



The 2024 numbers can be attributed to the unique market for existing homes in today's economy, combined with higher mortgage interest rates and homeowners retaining substantial equity.
